NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING Concerning Applications for Consent and Zoning Bylaw Amendments

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers will hold a public meeting on **Wednesday, August 28th, 2024 at 6:30 p.m.**, at the Township Office, 11 Birch Lake Road, Massey in order to consider the proposed applications for Consent under Section 53 of the Planning Act, RSO 1990 as amended as well as to consider amendments to the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw 2020-41 under Section 34(13) of the Planning Act, RSO 1990 as amended.

Consent File No. C-24-11 Purpose and Effect: To provide for the creation of two new lots within the Rural Zone. The property is described as Hallam Township, Concession 5, PT Lot 9, Parcel 778. The land in subject application is not subject to any other Planning Act application.

Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. ZBA-24-03 Purpose and Effect: To allow for a reduced front yard setback for a seasonal residence, with shoreline frontage, in the Resource Recreation zone. The property subject to this amendment is described as Gough Township, Parcel 16873, SWS SRL AB197, Plan RP53R10503, Part 4. The land in subject application is not subject to any other Planning Act application.

Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. ZBA-24-04 Purpose and Effect: To allow for a reduced interior yard setback and increased percentage of lot coverage for an accessory building in the Resource Recreation zone. The property subject to this amendment is described as Gough Township, Parcel 16592, SRL JDD 351. The land in subject application is not subject to any other Planning Act application.

TAKE NOTICE that if you wish to be notified of the decision of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers on the proposed application, you must make a written request to the Clerk of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers. To appeal the decision to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, send an appeal form to the Clerk of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers outlining the reasons for the appeal. You must enclose the applicable appeal fee for each application appealed, paid by cheque, made payable to the Ontario Minister of Finance.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers before the bylaw is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers before the decision is made, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Tribunal, unless in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

The role of the board is to ensure diversity representing the wider community, health equity for all, and work with staff and community groups in providing health care as the hub of the North Shore.

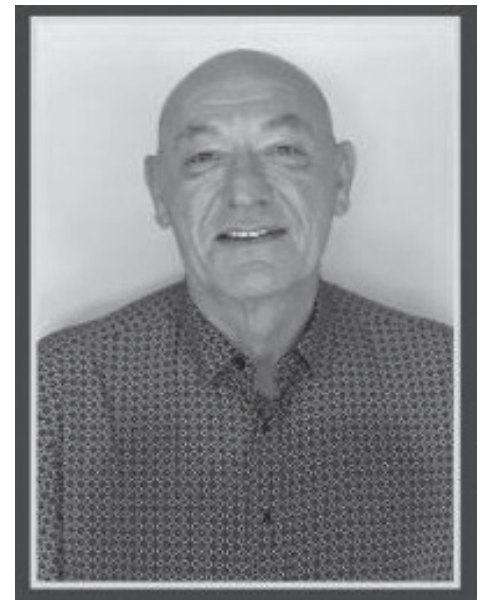

Former Espanola Police Officer Attending Historic Dedication In England For Family Member

By **Rosalind Russell** - Representing his family and his police service, a former Espanola Police officer will be going to England for a historical dedication.

Ed Stortz, who is now a member of the Windsor Police, is also the grandnephew of a fallen hero, Air Gunner Flying Officer John Alexander Glenn (J/36021) of the Royal Canadian Air Force.

Glenn, born in North Bay (Ferris) in 1925, attended North Bay Collegiate Vocational School and was a machine operator before enlisting in February 1943.

Stortz says he, his wife Paula (also a former Espanola Police officer), and daughter Jeana Martin, will be flying to the Memorial Dedication to honour and remember the crew of the Halifax III bomber (MZ311 EY-M) which crashed into Cleve Hill, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire in the early hours of August 26th, 1944.
