Changes to the Northern Ontario Health Travel Grant



By Rosalind Russell - Need to travel for health care? cancer treatment? surgery? Good news ... Ontario's Health Minister says travel grant changes will have started on December 1.

Promised changes to the Northern Ontario Health Travel Grant have come into effect.

In the Legislature last Tuesday, Health Minister Sylvia Jones reiterated the province's three-year, \$48 million funding announcement from earlier this year, with program expansions and improvements to start this past Sunday. "Starting on December 1 we have an additional enhancement that says 200 km is going to 100 km, \$75 per night for accommodations and expanding eligibility to include medical travel companions accompanying a patient," she says.

Public Health Sudbury & Districts Appoints New Associate Medical Officer Of Health.



By Rosalind Russell - The Board of Health has appointed Dr. Emily Groot as Associate Medical Officer of Health starting January 6,2025.

René Lapierre, the chair of the board, says Dr. Groot is working as Acting Associate Medical Officer of Health until her appointment is approved by the Minister of Health.

He says her appointment is part-time, so the



board is still looking for a second staffer to also work part-time to ensure they have full capacity as soon as possible.

Dr. Groot will maintain her part-time roles as Program Director with the Public Health and Preventive Medicine Residency Program at the NOSM University, as well as Medical Director of Réseau ACCESS Network's Treatment and Prevention clinic. Dr. Groot grew up in Northeastern Ontario. She previously served as Associate Medical Officer of Health for the Thunder Bay District Health Unit as well as for Niagara Region Public Health.

She has also worked as Regional Supervising Coroner for Northeastern Ontario and most recently as Medical Director of Sudbury's supervised consumption site.

Dr. Groot completed her medical education at McMaster University followed by speciality training in public health and preventive medicine at Queen's University. She also holds a Master of Public Health from the University of Toronto.

Espanola Council Approves Expenditure For Physician And Health Care Staff Recruitment



By Rosalind Russell - The Town of Espanola has had a long-time partnership with the Espanola Regional Hospital & Health Centre when it comes to physician and health care staff recruitment.

Hospital CEO Jane Battistelli and Dr. Rob Lepage, the Chief of Staff, met with Espanola Council last night to ask for \$20,000 to go towards recruitment. Practitioner and a crisis worker in the emergency department, filling frontline nursing positions, and a Stage One Submission to support a CT Scan.

She adds Ontario Health North has endorsed their CT Scan submission, which now sits with the Ministry of Health for approval.

Dr. Lepage adds they currently have vacancies for two full-time family physicians and two nurse practitioners' positions.

He says the support will help the hospital to bring physicians to the community and show case the health campus and physician model adding the funding would also be used to offset the estimated incentive costs of \$70,000.

Council thanked the two adding the ask of \$20,000 will be part of the pending 2025 budget talks.

Battistelli says past support has led to the hiring of a Nurse



According to the release, organizations are invited to participate in the municipality's next committee meeting to provide an opportunity for regional stakeholders to share updates on current projects or initiatives, exchange strategies, and explore collaborative efforts to promote sustainable lake health and more.

There will also be key areas of discussion including prevention and mitigation strategies, potential collaborations for funding and public education initiatives, water monitoring protocols and the feasibility of setting up boat wash stations at

key access points to prevent the spread of invasive species between lakes.


