## **Expanding Ornge With Two New, Very Fast Planes**

By Rosalind Russell - The province is expanding Ornge Air Ambulance's fleet by adding two larger, high-speed fixed-wing aircraft. part of a 93-million-dollar funding announcement that the province says will better connect people in northern and rural communities to the care they need when they need it. Officials say the two new, highspeed, Special Mission Aircraft can travel longer distances without refuelling. It means Ornge will be able to complete four long-distance transports per day — double the amount with its smaller planes. The announcement also includes money for Ornge to hire more frontline staff to improve prehospital care and better serve Indigenous communities.

By Rosalind Russell - The Ontario government is investing over \$75 million to rehabilitate 10 dams across the province to keep people and communities safe including two in Espanola and on in the Township of Huron Shores.

Resources says the construction projects will take place over the next four years and will extend the life of each dam to

ensure they continue to meet provincial standards for decades to come.

He adds rehabilitation could extend the useful service life of each dam for up to 100 years.

The Lang Lake Dam and the Frood Graydon Smith, Minister of Natural Lake Dam in the Espanola area will be rehabilitated as well as the Shaw Lake Dam in Huron Shores.

# Manitoulin Island Fish Farm Expanding To **Produce More Walleye** By Rosalind Russell - The Ontario

government is investing over \$75 million to update Ontario's fish hatchery program including Manitoulin Island.

Graydon Smith, Minister of Natural Resources, says infrastructure upgrades are planned for three critical fish culture stations to increase the production of key fish species and support fish stocking efforts.

He says a new building will be constructed for raising walleye at the Blue Jay Creek Fish Culture Station on Manitoulin Island to increase the production of walleye by as much as 600 percent annually.


He says improvements will be made to the North Bay Fish Culture Station to enable the stocking of over 555,000 highdemand fish, including brook, lake and rainbow trout.

The third project upgrades to the Hill's Lake Fish Culture Station in Englehart. Smith says upgrades will help increase its capacity to raise and stock over 530,000 popular fish including splake and aurora trout.
